Re: Return to full time schooling

As you may be aware the timeline for the staged return to onsite learning has been brought forward. All students will return to the classroom full time this Friday 22 October.

This has all been made possible thanks to parents, teachers, students, and the broader Victorian community stepping up to get vaccinated in great numbers across our community.

The Roadmap is based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer and sets out the staged return to onsite learning in Term 4.

Swan Hill College students will be in attendance at school as follows:

Up until Thursday 21 October

- Monday 18 Years 7, 11 and 12
- Tuesday 19 Years 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12
- Wednesday 20 Years 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 (Year 12 until recess only)
- Thursday 21 Years 7, 10 and 11

From Friday 22 October

- All students (Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11) will attend school 5 days per week
- Year 12 students will attend examinations

If our area is placed in lockdown, then those schools affected will revert to the settings in place at that time for metropolitan Melbourne.

Currently there are many students who are absent from school. To ensure our rolls are marked correctly, please contact the absence hotline on 5036 4996 or via email at absence@shc.vic.edu.au if your student is not at school.

Teachers will continue to place class work on DayMAP to be accessed, however after Thursday 21 October teachers will no longer be available to continue remote learning.

As previously communicated, secondary students are required to wear face masks unless they have an exemption. Please ensure that your child is bringing a mask to school.

Thank you again for your support and we look forward to having all our students onsite full time as of Friday.
